The Monash Health Renal Unit is based at Monash Medical Centre, Clayton and is one of the largest renal units in Australia. Experience is to be gained in all aspects of Nephrology, including transplantation. The Unit is well backed up by laboratory and clinical research teams and opportunities exist for higher degree studies as extensions of Advanced Physician training.
