Message from the Chief Medical Officer

 We are now officially 12 months away from our next organisation-wide national standards accreditation site survey, which will occur in July 2017. How time has flown – was it just 2 years ago that we went through our first survey under the new national standards accreditation framework? Next year we will still go through the same process and be surveyed against the same 10 standards and 256 actions, but version 2 of the national standards will come in from 2019 onwards which will have only 8 standards and 148 actions. The National Standards Accreditation Committee started meeting again this week, chaired by Assoc Prof Andrew Block as the acting Chief Operating Officer, which I attended, and planning has commenced to prepare for this major survey. As we approach survey time, Monash Doctors will get more communication from the Quality Unit and your Program Medical Directors of increasing activity around audits, training and policies and procedures, and I want to thank everyone in advance for their help and cooperation.

I attended a meeting at Monash University with the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences, Prof Christina Mitchell, together with Andrew Stripp, our Chief Executive, and Prof Eric Morand, Head of the School of Clinical Sciences at Monash Health, to discuss strengthening further the partnership between Monash Health and Monash University. The University remains committed to investing in a world class education precinct at the Clayton campus, and we are also streamlining the process of recruiting and appointing joint clinical academic (Professor/Director) roles. I will keep Monash Doctors up to date with this regard. On a similar vein, my portfolio leaders leading Medical Services, Patient Experience and Medical Education will also become adjuncts of the University, as we continue to partner with the School of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Monash Business School and Monash Arts Design and Architecture in the various different projects we are jointly involved in.
