PMCV JMO Forum Update

JMO Forum transitioned to online meetings in 2020 and met 5 times over the year. A significant focus was COVID and the impact on JMO's wellbeing and education. The JMO forum also implemented the Central Listing Service by PMCV in 2020. Monash Health representatives Gabriella Wong and Trudy Hong were involved in various projects with Trudy Hong taking on the role of project lead in the project "Furthering Our Understanding of Prevocational Medical Training". This project follows on from previous work that

"established the current practices of prevocational medical training. There is a clear discrepancy that regional and rural sites are disadvantaged by access to training and the group seeks to develop a means of understanding this discrepancy further."

Gabriella Wong worked with the committee to develop strategies that may improve the JMO experience of night and cover shifts, with a particular focus on rural health services. These were submitted to Medical Workforce by the relevant JMO committee representatives

Originally a 2019 project, the referral cheat sheet was sourced from Sunshine Coast University

Working closely with Dr Chris Chew (HMO3), the 2020 Committee has sought feedback from most specialties across Monash Health to update the existing cheat sheet and expand it's inclusion. This is still a work in progress, and will be completed by the incoming committee. The lanyard card with a link to the cheat-sheet was provided to all 2021 Interns during Orientation.

COVID-19 FAQ document

The committee worked with Monash Doctors Workforce to collate, theme and produce a document answering some of the many COVID based non-clinical questions from JMS. These ranged from leave entitlements, rotation freezes, impact on assessments and a variety of other topics.
