

National Standards Training for all Medical Employees

National Standards training is available on the Monash Health Learning platform *Latte*, which can be accessed via the Monash Learning icon available on your desktop, as well as on the Monash Health Intranet. You can sign in using your employee number.

What training do I need to do for each National Standard?

As an employee of Monash Health you are required to complete **Mandatory** and **Targeted** Quality and Safety training. This list is also available in the PROMPT mandatory and target training procedure.

What courses do Senior Medical Staff need to do?

In addition to the suite of Mandatory Training modules that all Monash Health staff must complete, Senior Medical Staff must also complete targeted training that may be required for specific programs or their roles. All new starters should complete their training modules **within one month** of appointment.

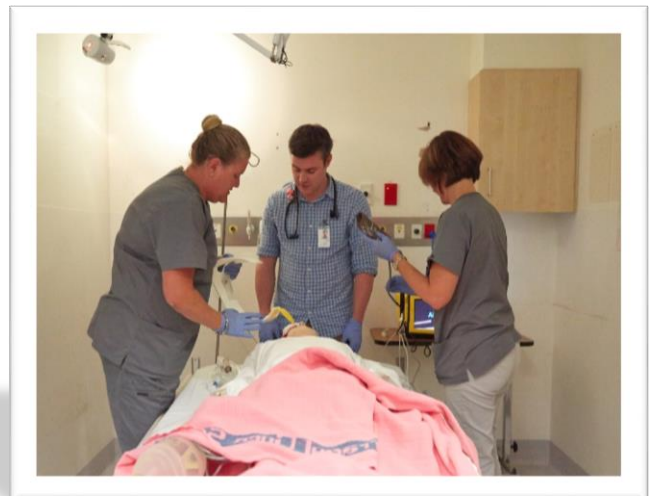
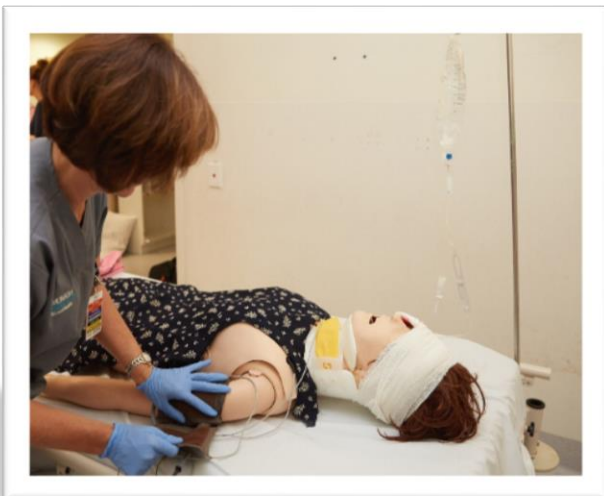

Employees will fulfil Deteriorating Patient Training if they have completed any one of the six modules

Adult Basic Life Support (MDBL01) –Annual
Paediatric Basic Life Support (NMPL01) –Annual
Neonatal first Response (NMNR01) –Annual
Advanced Adult Life Support (NMAL01) –Every 3 years
Advanced Paediatric Life Support (NMLS01) # –Every 3 years
Advanced neonatal resuscitation (MDNA01) # –Every 2 years
