External Registrations



Registering Births, Deaths, Marriages

This is really important for when you need to certify death certificates – if you register first, then you can be ready to complete the task without delay or confusion. Remember to use your work address and contact details (not home). [Link](#)

Smartphone applications and resources



Microsoft Teams

You will be required to have access to Microsoft teams. Make sure this is download onto your devices that will be used in O week.



Baret Application

Once you have installed Microsoft Teams on your personal device, you will need to add, pin, and register the Barret app within Microsoft Teams. To add Baret to MS Teams, search for 'Baret' in the Microsoft Teams Apps library or [click here to directly add Baret](#). To pin Baret to your toolbar, right-click the added app and select 'pin'.

BMJ Best Practice App

Access BMJ Best Practice via the Monash [Monash Health Library website](#). Log in with MH credentials and use your MH email to register when creating your account.



MIMS Mobile

To access MIMS Mobile you must first register for a [Clinicians Health Channel \(CHC\) account](#)

You can always access MIMS in a web browser from the [clinical decision support tools page](#) on the library website.



Up-To-Date

Use [this Monash Health link](#) to go to UpToDate. Complete registration process to create a username and password. Download and log into the mobile app with your new registration details. The mobile app provides the easiest access to this essential tool.

You can also use your login to access UpToDate from the desktop icon on MH computers or the [clinical decision support tools page](#) on the library website.



Therapeutic Guidelines (eTG)

Request a token with the [Token Request](#) link. You need to do this on a computer within the Monash Health network and provide your work email. You will then receive an email with an eTG token and instructions.

You can then download the eTG mobile app and use your individual token to connect to Therapeutic Guidelines content. A download of Instructions is located [here](#).



ClinicalKey

You need to create a personal account if you wish to access ClinicalKey eBooks or use the database remotely. Visit [ClinicalKey](#) and click register in the top right.



BMJ Learning

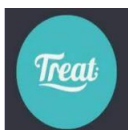
