

National Standards Training for all Medical Employees

National Standards training is available on the Monash Health Learning platform *Latte*, which can be accessed via the Monash Learning icon available on your desktop, as well as on the Monash Health Intranet. You can sign in using your employee number. Training compliance is being monitored regularly by the organization.



What training do I need to do for each National Standard?

As an employee of Monash Health you are required to complete **Mandatory** and **Targeted** Quality and Safety training. This list is also available in the PROMPT mandatory and target training procedure.

What courses do Junior Medical Staff need to do?

In addition to the suite of Mandatory Training modules that all Monash Health staff must complete, Junior Medical Staff must also complete targeted training that may be required for specific programs for their roles. All Interns must complete their training modules **during orientation week**.

Please note: If you have completed Monash Health online training before your intern year (i.e. as a student or part-time), you will need to complete it again under your Intern employee number.

All Interns must complete the modules outlined below **by the end of orientation week.**

Modules in **GREEN** must be completed **PRIOR** to Wednesday's shadow shift.

Modules in **BLUE** must be completed by Thursday
