Monash Intern Mentoring Project

Commencing in 2021, this junior doctor lead initiative links new interns with PGY2s to support their transition from student to doctor.

2022 has already seen an increase of 30 Interns and 20 HMOs sign up to be involved from the 40+ Interns/HMOs in 2021 with a number of the 2021 Interns signing up to be mentors in 2022.

Presentation at Intern Orientation

Five committee members kindly presented at the 2023 Intern Orientation Program, providing an opportunity for 2023 Interns to ask questions of current JMS. When asked if the session was helpful, the incoming interns rated it 4.4/5 and it was highlighted multiple times as a particularly useful session. We thank them for their time.

Monash Doctors Teach Students

Initiated by JMO Victoria, MDTS is a Monash Doctors and School of Clinical Sciences support program, which provided final year Medical students with the opportunity to learn from Monash JMS. This was supported by MDE and over the intial 8 week trial period, 71 JMS registered as tutors and 31 tutorials were held. There was such a large uptake from students a waitlist was required. From the feedback, 96% of students found the tutorials useful. We look forward to continuing to support this project in 2023.

Updating of Shadow Shift documents

The JMS education and training committee played a pivotal role in refining the shadow shift documents for the 2023 Interns. The shadow shift documents work as an orientation tool for Interns on their shadow days, it provides the incoming interns with prompts for things they should clarify and explore while on their shadow day.

In addition the Committee was able to develop EMR top tips for new incoming interns. Tips that would be useful for interns to utilise while they are still relativley unfamiliar with EMR.

Developing Learning Packages

The JMS Committee in conjunction with MDE directors of clinical training and the Med education manager worked to develop learning packages around the management of deteriorating patient designed for interns. The new Gols of Care module is centered around 4 cases and can be found on Latte. The module. includes interactive guizzes, images, information and tips that could be utilised by junior medical staff to develop their knowledge around the management of a deteriorating patient.
